7) A 3NT opener promises a solid minor suit preempt of course...

of the three responding hands given , with ii and iii partner would pass the 3NT bid { they would gamble that 9 tricks might come in }.

Only with i would partner wish to run from 3NT by bidding4C.

8) Win the Hrt and lead the 2 sp to the King in dummy.

If the K holds lead the 5 sp back and play the 3 from hand { hoping that the Ace has to be played on your 3 Sp }.

9) We have 4 losers and need to reduce that number but fast.

Play Ace Hrts , then K Hrts , then small diamond to the Q in dummy. Then play Q Hrts and throw a club. Then , draw trumps.

Risky but you will go down if you dont try the above.

10) North should realise that the 4Sp bid by partner was a gambling raise based on distributional features.
Passing 4Sp was a better idea than going for 6.

11) North should realise that her partner has bid a DGR { look it up if you cant remember }. Such a sequence is encouraging and N should go for a slam.

9) Well we have ended up in a 3NT with only 23 pts . Perhaps someone has overbid !!
And of course it is you the opener who has reversed and forced partner to bid at the 3 level
{ with your 3 D rebid}.

A better auction would have been :

1S-----2H

2S-----2NT

Pass.

But But Butdoesnt 1S followed by 2Sp promise a six card suit? .No.
