- 1) 1C-----1H
2C
not strong enough for 3 C
- 2) 3D shows 15/16 (17) pts
and a six card suit
- 3) 2C
Any other rebid is wrong!
If you actually rebid 2D
then ...you really dont get
reverses do you?
- 4) 1NT 15/16 pts and balanced
- 5) 3NT -18/19pts after a two level
response
- 6) 3D see remarks to answer {2} above
- 7) Pass. NB ONLY bid 2NT with 17+
- 8) 3NT -should be a chance to make game BUT in NTs and NOT in clubs
- 9) 3NT -yes yes I do know we have nothing in spades thank you. 3NT this week last
week and next week.
- 10) 3H { check back bid }
- 11) 6NT ie partner has 18/19 we have 14
give it a whirl. For the less adventurous 4NT is ok.
- 12) 2S was pants. Why ? if you dont know that 2S is a reverse yet well ...there are other
games than bridge you might like to try.
- 13) 2NT was not enough. Oh why ??? you cry , "I only had 9 pts ".
Well partner's 2H bid was a reverse showing 17 pts . Your 9 makes 26 so.....
3NT it should have been.
- 14) "Bloody partner with her top of nothing leads in my suit again" . {Strident enough ?}
When partner led the 8 and followed with a smaller card it looked like partner
had originally held only a doubleton { the 8 , 5 }. What the leader must do with 8 5 2
is lead the 2 { if this is partner's bid sit } then noone will think you only have two.
- 15) Looks a better bet to win Ace hrts and play 3 rounds of diamonds to throw a heart.
Then draw trumps.
- 16) Win the lead and claim !!!! { well you may have to explain that you have 9 tricks on
top -ie 4 x spades + 1 x Hrt + 4 x clubs }.
- 17) Win Ace hrts and play a spade. Why do we win and not *execute* a wait when weak play ?
Well A2-----10987 is not weak !! If you play the Ace on the K then the 10 will
make a trick in due course { and save your bacon }.
- 18) open 3NT. Like a bit of a gamble don't you ?
